

Political Disclosure Statement

Oklahoma Elections 2012

Primary March 6, 2012 (Protection begins 1/21/12)

Primary June 26, 2012 (Protection begins 5/12/12)

Runoff August 28, 2012 (Protection begins 7/14/12)

General Election November 6, 2012 (Protection begins 9/7/12)

During their election campaigns, all legally qualified Federal Candidates are entitled to purchase time on KSBI-TV and KSBI-TV 52.2. (hereinafter referred to as 'station'). 'Station' will consider all requests for such time and will make reasonable accommodations to meet such requests. Each Federal Candidate has the right to "reasonable access" to the facilities of 'station' for the airing of political advertisements. Station has ultimate discretion with respect to the placement of political advertisements. 'Station' will grant access to specified state and local candidates, based, in the 'station's' sole discretion, on the public interest in the election and in the availability of inventory. During the 45 days preceding a Primary Election and the 60 days before a General Election, 'station' will charge candidates in the respective elections the "lowest unit charge" for an advertisement if the advertisement constitutes a "use" of the 'station' facilities. The advertisement is considered to be a "use" if it includes the candidate's readily identifiable likeness and is controlled, sponsored or approved by the candidate or the candidate's campaign committee. During any period other than the 45-day and 60-day periods, the charges for political advertisements constituting a "use" will be no higher than those charged other advertisers for comparable use of the station's facilities. Any political advertisement that is not a "use", including any advertisement purchased by an independent Political Action Committee or any advertisement dealing with non-candidate ballot issues, is sold at prevailing commercial rates. If a political advertisement constitutes a "use", 'station' will provide opposing candidates with "equal opportunities", as established by Federal Law. Inquiries may be made to:

The terms and conditions applicable to political advertising on 'station' are as follows:

- 1. Sponsorship Identification.** Complete sponsor identification must be included in each advertisement as required by the FCC Rules and Regulations. 'Station' reserves the right to insert such identification into any advertisement that fails to include the requisite sponsorship identification even if the insertion of the sponsorship identification causes a portion of the advertisement to be deleted.
- 2. Credit.** By Federal law all payments must be made in advance of the advertising schedule. Payment is due for schedule and any production charges at the time services are rendered and twenty-four hours before the first announcement airs.

3. **Political Agreement.** A signed agreement form for political broadcasts must accompany all time orders. This form must list the Directors, or Officers of the political entity purchasing the time.

4. **Proof of Candidacy.** 'Station' at its option, may require the candidate to produce proof that he/she is legally qualified candidate.

5. **Deadlines and Weekend Access.** Orders must be placed at least three business days in advance of start. Copy changes or cancellations require one business day notice. Tapes and written instructions must be delivered to the station in advance of start of scheduled airdate. Deadlines for contract changes and commercial materials are:

- 12 noon Friday for Sunday and Monday's log
- 12 noon Monday for Tuesday's log
- 12 noon Tuesday for Wednesday's log
- 12 noon Wednesday for Thursday's log
- 12 noon Thursday for Friday and Saturday's log

Weekend access is available on the weekend prior to each primary and general election through the names attached.

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6. **Production Facilities.** The 'station's' production facilities will be available to produce commercials for political advertisers on the same terms as provided to commercial advertisers.

7. **Schedules.** 'Station' will make available to Federal candidates any and all dayparts and unsold inventory and any special packages that are available to commercial advertisers. For information regarding packages and rotations not listed in the description below, please call the 'station'. 'Station' will also make reasonable efforts to accommodate requests for packages designed by candidates. Although the rates charged by 'station' are based upon the use of either :60 or :30 commercials. 'Station' will also try to accommodate requests for advertisements of non-standard length.

8. **Rates.** Estimated lowest unit charges. Rates provided at time of request.

9. **Make Good Policy.** In the event of a missed commercial, 'station' will make good in the same daypart within three days. If time prohibits making the commercial good, (e.g., missed on last day before election), 'station' will refund cost of missed commercial to the purchasing entity within five working days.

10. **Election Day Orders.** Political advertising, at the stations' discretion, may be accepted on Election Day. Must be placed in accordance with stated deadlines.

11. **Rebates.** If a new lowest unit charge is established after a political advertiser's purchase has been made or run, 'station' will rebate the overcharge to the candidate's future time purchases, as the candidate directs.

12. **Local Public Inspection File.** The rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission require that each station must maintain and permit public inspection of a complete record of all requests for political time, together with an appropriate notation showing whether such requests were granted and the amount charged. This information must be retained in the station's local public inspection file for two years. The local inspection file for station is maintained at 9802 N. Morgan Rd., Yukon, OK. Any member of the public, including opposing candidates, is entitled to inspect the materials placed in these files during regular business hours. No telephone, facsimile or mail requests for local public file information will be accepted.

13. **Contact.** In order to provide maximum service to candidates and their representatives, 'station' seeks to provide services through sales management. Any of the 'station's' personnel will take questions and messages from candidates and their representatives. The actual time buy will be handled by Cheri Greeson General Sales Manager, who can be reached at 405-470-0993
